The items on Chart 1 below are available for check out from the Camp Greene Wood Office (Manitou). There is no fee for the use of council equipment. However, many items are in constant demand. Therefore it is extremely important that equipment is returned on time. Equipment must be returned complete and in clean, dry condition. Contact the Girl Scout office if you have a conflict with the return date of your equipment.

Loan Equipment Requisitions must be submitted no less than ten (10) working days prior to the pick up date. Requisitions received without the required notice may not be honored. If you are camping at Camp Greene Wood or Camp River Trails, your equipment order will be waiting for you when you arrive and check in at camp. Equipment being used off site (non Greene Wood or River Trails sites) must be picked up and returned as on the date indicated on the requisition form.

- Additional equipment cannot be added to the order on the day of pick up
- Record problems on the requisition form – leave the form in the bin with the equipment
